Dear Friends,

As you are already aware from our correspondence of April 2nd 2007 (see attached) it is now requirement for the National Federations granting a Letter of Clearance to include information on the Player's Agent involved. To this end, national federation will have to specify:

- The name of the FIBA Licensed Agent (if the player has retained a FIBA Licensed agent)
- The name of the Agent if the latter is not FIBA Licensed Agent
- The fact that the player does not make use of the services of an Agent

Additionally, we kindly ask you to send a copy of all Letters of Clearance you may issue to the FIBA Secretariat at + 41 22 545 0099.

Please ensure that the above mentioned is always provided so that we are able to monitor the movement of the players and the activities of Players Agents and inform the FIBA Zones accordingly via our FNA database.
